

Operating instructions for LABC-Cold-Air-Dryer for TLC records



The LABC-Cold-Air-Dryer serves for the reproduceable dry of TLC records and foils.

Operation:

- 1. Device drawer forwards pulled out.
- 2. Record insert concentric and close the drawer again.
- 3. Net plugs pocket.
- 4. Device about the green seesaw counter switch on which shines then green.
- 5. About the black step counter you choose the strength of the airflow.

Step 1: two ventilators

Step 2: four ventilators

Aerial throughput per ventilator (free-blowing): 59 m³/H

Exchanging the filter mat (see also device):

- 1. Net plugs move.
- 2. Knurled nut in the back unscrew.
- 3. Upper case part approx. 20 cm to the back move and take off upwards.
- 4. The filter mat exchange.
- 5. Case upper top again from the back put on, up to push all the way to the stop and screw together.
- 6. Net plugs pocket.

The change interval is directed after the duration of the application time and the lab circumstances. Yearly change is recommended.

All electric components are CE-compliant.
